# EGERTON UNIVERSITY ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

Egerton University Alumni Association was formed in February, 1984, by former students of the then Egerton College with the following objectives:

- to promote the image, integrity and principles of Egerton University as an institution of higher learning especially in the field of Agriculture;
- to disseminate agricultural information to the rural areas so as to enhance agricultural development in Kenya;
- to promote the exchange of socio-cultural ideas among the Alumni and the University community through the organization of related seminars, tours and meetings;
- to solicit for support from the public and private sectors to further develop the University;
- to acquire and disseminate information on employment opportunities for the Alumni;
- to reward students/Alumni for exemplary scholarship;
- to promote qualitative research activities within the University;
- to enhance the publication and dissemination of educational materials within the University;
- to encourage and finance selected student socio-cultural activities such as sports, art exhibitions, music and the establishment of agricultural archives in the University;
- to organize such income generating activities as dances, films and auctions with the aim of raising funds for the development of the University; and
- to be involved in decision making processes in the University.

Membership to the Association is open to the following:

- all graduates of the College/University on payment of a registration fee of one hundred shillings (KSh. 100/=); and
- senior academic/administrative staff in the University.

Honorary membership can be extended to anybody who has contributed significantly to the objectives of the Association.

Having been inaugurated at the time when the College was about to be transformed into University-College status, the Association played a very significant role by offering advice to the "Ayany Commission" which was appointed by the Government to work out modalities of upgrading the College into a University.

The Association was quite instrumental in reviewing the former diploma courses with the aim of either maintaining them or upgrading them into degree programmes.

The Association also made tangible recommendations on the future administrative structure of Egerton College in its new role as a university. Besides that the association featured prominently in the review of the terms of service for staff.

The Association also instituted the credit-transfer provision, which was effected early this year (1993) for the diploma holders of the College who enrol for degree programmes in the University.

The EUAA - Secretariat, which is located in the Office of the Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Academic Affairs (Main Administration Block Room 119) welcomes all the newly graduated Alumni as well as the old ones to join the Association.

## **A BRIEF HISTORY OF EGERTON UNIVERSITY**

In 1939, Lord Egerton of Tatton donated 320 hectares of land to the Department of Agriculture for the establishment of an agricultural school. The first buildings were constructed in 1940/41 but the first three students were admitted in 1939 on makeshift accommodation. Those early students were British ex-servicemen returning from World War II, who were being prepared for farming in the Kenya Highlands. Initially courses were informal, and only in the mid-1940s were formal nine months certificate courses introduced. In 1949 the Diploma in Agriculture was initiated.

In 1955 the Government handed over the management of the college to a Board of Governors. When Lord Egerton died in 1958, he left the college a further 1,125 hectares of land.

In 1960, when it was obvious that Kenya's political independence was inevitable, the Act had to be amended and the Board re-organised to allow the College which was up to then an exclusive European preserve, to admit non-European students beginning 1961.

Training was also focused more on the needs and aspirations of an independent Kenya, particularly in agricultural fields.

In 1986, the College was granted University College status and admitted the first 137 degree students in September.

In 1987, the University College was granted full University status by an Act of Parliament.

The University has continued to grow in student numbers, staff, physical facilities as well as the number and type of courses offered. Presently, there are 394 students pursuing six different diploma programmes and 7557 undergraduate students pursuing 14 different degree programmes. The academic staff population stands at 802.

This phenomenal growth is a reflection of the importance Kenya attaches to both development of Education and Agriculture. The University has been associated with these areas of national endeavour throughout its existence.
