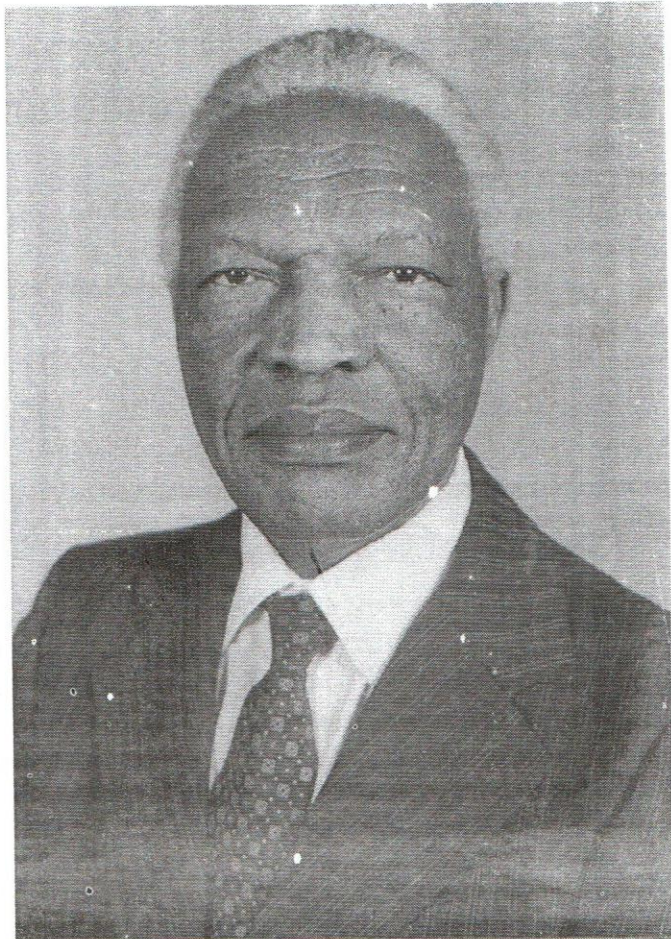

A BRIEF HISTORY OF EGERTON UNIVERSITY

Egerton University started as an Agricultural School in 1939, when it admitted the first three students in makeshift premises.

Today, it is an acknowledged degree awarding institution with a reputation as a Centre of Excellence in Agriculture. It also offers various courses in Education, Natural and Applied Sciences, Arts and Social Sciences.

The first three students of the institution were ex-world war II British servicemen who required basic training in agriculture prior to settling in Kenya Highlands. The mode of instructions at Egerton Agricultural College remained informal until the mid-1940's when a formal nine-month certificate course was introduced. The School was subsequently elevated to an Agricultural college. A Diploma programme was initiated in 1949 and in 1955, the Government handed the management of the college to a Board of Governors through an Act of Parliament.

In 1986, the college was elevated to a constituent college of the University of Nairobi and in 1987 it was granted University status by an act of Parliament.

The University has three campuses. The Main Campus (Njoro Campus), is located 180 kilometres North West of Nairobi and 30 kilometres from Nakuru on a 1445-hectare piece of land donated by the Lord Maurice Egerton of Tatton (1874-1958), (320 ha in 1939 and 1,125 ha in 1958). Situated at an altitude of approximately 2,250 metres, with excellent climate, and in an ideal locality. This campus provides a conducive academic atmosphere.

The second campus (Laikipia College Campus) is located near Nyahururu town some 45 kilometres from Nakuru, on a 365-hectare piece of land formerly occupied by Laikipia Teachers College. This College, inter-alia, offers Bachelors Degree in education (Arts) and the Postgraduate Diploma courses in education which are offered to aspiring secondary school teachers. The third campus (Kisii College Campus) is situated in Kisii town on a 24-hectare piece of land formerly occupied by Kisii Teachers College.

Since its inauguration Egerton University has continued to expand. Currently, the University has the following programmes: Twenty (20) undergraduate degree, six (6) diploma, fifteen (15) masters (six in sciences and nine in arts), one (2) Post graduate diploma (in Education) and 4 doctorate. It has 42 departments in eight faculties with 3,181 staff members (academic, administrative and support), and 8,096 students pursuing various undergraduate and post-graduate diploma and degree programmes.

To be able to reach its local community, the university established two training centers in Nakuru town, mostly offering self sponsored programmes and short term certificate courses.

EGERTON UNIVERSITY ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

Egerton University Alumni Association was formed on February 1984, by former students with the following objectives.

To promote the image, integrity and principles of Egerton University as an institution of higher learning especially in the field of agriculture

To disseminate agricultural information to the rural areas so as to enhance agricultural development in Kenya

To promote exchange of socio-cultural ideas among Alumni and the University community through organisations of related seminars, tours and meetings.

To solicit for support from the public and private sectors to further develop the University.

To acquire and disseminate information of employment opportunities for Alumni.

To reward students/Alumni for exemplary scholarship

To promote qualitative research activities within the University

To enhance the publication and dissemination of educational materials within the university.

To organise such income generating activities as dances, films and auctions with the aim of raising funds for the development of the University and

To be involved in decision making process in the University

Membership to the Association is open to the following:-

All graduates of the University on payment of a registration fee of Kenya Shillings one hundred (Ksh.100/=)

Senior academic and administrative staff in the University

Honorary membership can be extended to anybody who has contributed significantly to the objectives of the Association.

Inaugurated at the time when the college was about to be transformed into University-college status, the Association played an important role by offering advice to "Ayany Commission" which was appointed by the government to work on the modalities of upgrading the College into a University.

The Association also made tangible recommendations on the future administration structure of Egerton College in its new role as a University. Besides that the Association featured prominently in the review of the terms for service for staff.

The Association instituted the credit transfer provision which was effected at the beginning of 1993 for Diploma holder of the college who enrol for Degree programmes in the University.

The EUAA - Secretariat which falls under the office of the deputy Vice Chancellor (Academic Affairs) welcomes all newly graduated Alumni as well as the old ones to join the association.
